Major Retailer Improves Stock Replenishment Cycle with Implementation of Mobile Monarch® 9416™ Solution

Background: This major retailer is a 180 store “big box” retailer.

Business Challenge: This retailer has implemented Monarch hardware, supplies and service for a variety of applications over the last several years. The latest solution (implemented last year) provides a system-generated pick slip for the replenishment of out-of-stock product.

Prior to the implementation of the Monarch solution, this retailer's personnel walked the sales floor and placed colored dot labels on fixtures of out of stock merchandise. A different associate walked the floor later, found the colored label dots and created a manual log of items that needed to be re-stocked. It was not uncommon to see colored dots on the same fixture for more than a week.

Avery Dennison Solution: The Monarch Out-of-Stock Solution includes a Monarch 9416 desktop printer on a Monarch Mobile Work Station.

Here's How it Works. As an associates pushes the mobile work station containing the Monarch 9416 printer through the aisles, he or she scans the shelf label or item barcode for out-of-stock and soon to be out of stock merchandise.



After six or seven scans, a 4 x 6 tag or pick list is printed on the Monarch 9416 printer. The tag pick lists are turned in to the manager who retrieves the product from back stock and stocks the shelves.

The Monarch 9416 Out-of-Stock Solution helped this retailer decrease the occurrence of out-of-stocks, and shorten the amount of time it takes to replenish inventory.

Additionally, inventory accuracy improved due to the elimination of illegible hand writing in the former process.
